



**Policy Name: Bundled Services Policy – Medica Commercial and Medicaid – Status "B" Codes Eligible for Reimbursement**

**The following codes are eligible for reimbursement subject to the member's certificate of coverage and Medica Reimbursement Policies. Inclusion of a procedure on this list does not imply health insurance coverage or reimbursement.**

15850	Removal of sutures under anesthesia (other than local), same surgeon
36416	Collection of capillary blood specimen (eg, finger, heel, ear stick)
36540	Collection of blood specimen from a completely implantable venous access device
90887	Interpretation or explanation of results of psychiatric, other medical examinations and procedures, or other accumulated data to family or other responsible persons, or advising them how to assist patient
92371	Repair and refitting spectacles; spectacle prosthesis for aphakia
96040	Medical genetics and genetic counseling services, each 30 minutes face-to-face with patient/family
97602	Removal of devitalized tissue from wound(s), non-selective debridement, without anesthesia (eg, wet-to-moist dressings, enzymatic, abrasion), including topical application(s), wound assessment, and instruction(s) for ongoing care, per session
98960	Education and training for patient self-management by a qualified, nonphysician health care professional using a standardized curriculum, face-to-face with the patient (could include caregiver/family) each 30 minutes; individual patient <a href="#">Allowed for diabetes education only</a>
98961	Education and training for patient self-management by a qualified, nonphysician health care professional using a standardized curriculum, face-to-face with the patient (could include caregiver/family) each 30 minutes; 2-4 patients <a href="#">Allowed for diabetes education only</a>
98962	Education and training for patient self-management by a qualified, nonphysician health care professional using a standardized curriculum, face-to-face with the patient (could include caregiver/family) each 30 minutes; 5-8 patients <a href="#">Allowed for diabetes education only</a>
99000	Handling and/or conveyance of specimen for transfer from the physician's office to a laboratory
99001	Handling and/or conveyance of specimen for transfer from the patient in other than a physician's office to a laboratory (distance may be indicated)
99002	Handling, conveyance, and/or any other service in connection with the implementation of an order involving devices (eg, designing, fitting, packaging, handling, delivery or mailing) when devices such as orthotics, protectives, prosthetics are fabricated by an outside laboratory or shop but which items have been designed, and are to be fitted and adjusted by the attending physician
99078	Physician educational services rendered to patients in a group setting (eg, prenatal, obesity, or diabetic instructions) <a href="#">For commercial products, allowed for diabetes education only.</a> <a href="#">For Minnesota Health Care Programs products, allowed for diabetes and childbirth education only.</a>
99091	Collection and interpretation of physiologic data (eg, ECG, blood pressure, glucose monitoring) digitally stored and/or transmitted by the patient and/or caregiver to the physician or other qualified health care professional, requiring a minimum of 30 minutes of time
99100	Anesthesia for patient of extreme age, under 1 year and over 70 (List separately in addition to code for primary anesthesia procedure)
99116	Anesthesia complicated by utilization of total body hypothermia (List separately in addition to code for primary anesthesia procedure)
99135	Anesthesia complicated by utilization of controlled hypotension (List separately in addition to code for primary anesthesia procedure)

99140	Anesthesia complicated by emergency conditions (specify) (List separately in addition to code for primary anesthesia procedure)
99288	Physician direction of emergency medical systems (EMS) emergency care, advanced life support
99361	Medical conference by a physician with interdisciplinary team of health professionals or representatives of community agencies to coordinate activities of patient care (patient not present); approximately 30 minutes. <a href="#">Allowed for MSHO and Medicaid only.</a>
99362	Medical conference by a physician with interdisciplinary team of health professionals or representatives of community agencies to coordinate activities of patient care (patient not present); approximately 60 minutes. <a href="#">Allowed for MSHO and Medicaid only.</a>
99371	Telephone call by a physician to patient or for consultation or medical management or for coordinating medical management with other health care professionals (eg, nurses, therapists, social workers, nutritionists, physicians, pharmacists); simple or brief (eg, to report on tests and/or laboratory results, to clarify or alter previous instructions, to integrate new information from other health professionals into the medical treatment plan, or to adjust therapy)
99372	Telephone call by a physician to patient or for consultation or medical management or for coordinating medical management with other health care professionals (eg, nurses, therapists, social workers, nutritionists, physicians, pharmacists); intermediate (eg, to provide advice to an established patient on a new problem, to initiate therapy that can be handled by telephone, to discuss test results in detail, to coordinate medical management of a new problem in an established patient, to discuss and evaluate new information and details, or to initiate new plan of care)
99373	Telephone call by a physician to patient or for consultation or medical management or for coordinating medical management with other health care professionals (eg, nurses, therapists, social workers, nutritionists, physicians, pharmacists); complex or lengthy (eg, lengthy counseling session with anxious or distraught patient, detailed or prolonged discussion with family members regarding seriously ill patient, lengthy communication necessary to coordinate complex services of several different health professionals working on different aspects of the total patient care plan)
