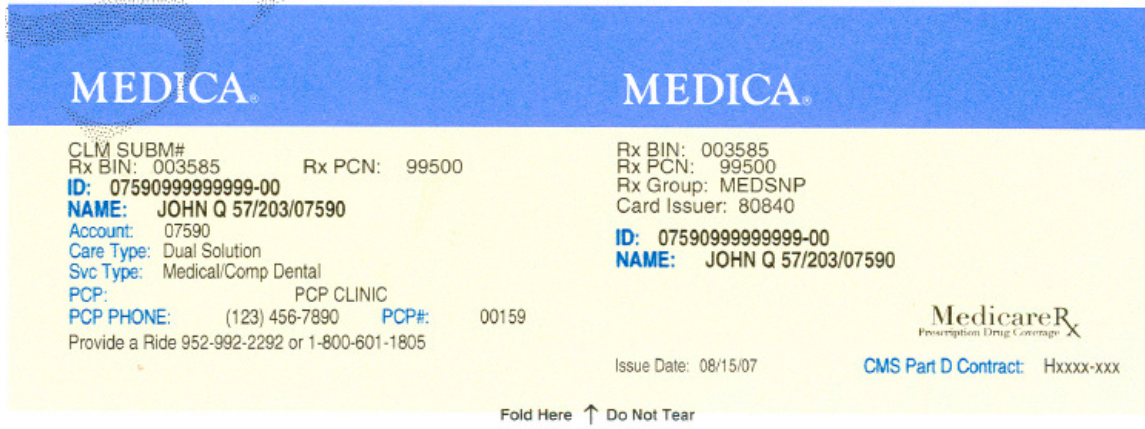


Medica Provider Fact Sheet on Medica Dual Solution®

Overview

Minnesota Senior Health Options – MSHO. This product is for members who are eligible for Medicaid and are 65+ years of age. The Care System is assigned based on the member’s primary provider. This program is offered in 33 counties throughout Minnesota. There are over 9,000 members enrolled in this product.

Program Features

- Medicare and Medicaid products are purchased under one combined package.
- DHS contracts with subcontractors capable of providing the full range of integrated primary, acute and long-term care services on a capitated-risk basis.
- Eligible members may receive coverage of all Medicare parts A and B, and coverage of all services under the current home- and community-based waiver (Elderly Waiver).
- A care coordinator is the member’s primary contact for assessing all benefits.

Care Systems:

A Care System consists of a system of providers that span the continuum of care including doctors, nurses, clinics, hospitals, nursing homes and social workers. A geriatric-focused care team of doctors, nurses and social workers work together to coordinate the members’ services. Care systems for Dual Solution:

- Care Systems contract with primary care providers to be included in their care system.

 - Chiropractic Care – ACN

MSHO Membership Criteria

- Qualify for Medicaid
- Have Medicare benefits
- Be at least 65 years of age
- Live in the service area
- Willing to enroll – MSHO is a voluntary program

Referral Process

- Referrals are required for the payment of the following claim types:
 - Customized living
 - Foster care
 - Home modifications – code S5165
 - Generic Supplies and equipment – code T2029
 - Nursing Home stays – Medicare A stays or skilled stays
 - PCA
 - Lifeline – codes S5160 and S5161
 - Home Health Aids
 - Homemakers effective 12/1/09
