What it is

Effective January 1, 2006, the U of MN will have seven (7) Medica plans available to U of MN employees. The plans are:

- Medica Direct® HRA
- Medica Direct® HSA

Benefits

- Mental health and substance abuse services will be managed through United Behavioral Health
- Prescription drug benefits administered through Rx America, 1-866-918-7526

Deviations

- Elect and Essential plans will have U of MN Physicians and Boynton Health Services as a care system, for U of MN members only
- Members on Elect and Essential will be able to switch between Elect and Essential monthly, however all family members must be on the same plan, family cannot split between Elect and Essential.
- All plans have UMD Health Services as an in-network provider
- All plans have QuickCare as an Urgent Care provider
- Group numbers beginning with 838 have access to UHC Options PPO II network
- Group numbers beginning with 839 have access to MultiPlan national network
