Optimally Managed Vascular Care	Percent of members who have vascular disease and reached all of the following four treatment goals to reduce risk of cardiovascular diseases: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Blood pressure less than 140/90 mmHg (if the patient also has diabetes the BP must be <130/80) ▪ LDL-C less than 100 mg/dl ▪ Daily aspirin use for patient ▪ Documented as tobacco-free in medical record 	MN Community Measurement Results	Health Plan: Claims and medical record review-random sample OR Direct data submission: (must have both baseline and comparison year)	18 to 75 years of age	Improvement over baseline of at least 4 percentage points	Improvement over baseline of at least 6 percentage points; or if at 90th percentile of MNCM aggregate	Percent of members with vascular disease who met criteria as optimally managed in 2007 (2008 MNCM measurement results report for DOS 2007)	Participating providers ¹ eligible for MNCM and a minimum of 45 Medica <i>commercial</i> members ² with vascular disease. MNCM Vascular Disease measure provider specialties include: Cardiologist managing care (not device check only), Family Practice, General Practice, Geriatric Medicine, Internal Medicine, Med/Peds. Includes provider types who manage care – MD, Physician Assistant, Nurse Practitioner
